



Scheme of Subjects for Class XI

The Lawrence School, Sanawar offers the following four streams for the students in Class XI.

1. Humanities
2. Commerce (Without Mathematics)
3. Commerce (With Applied Mathematics)
4. Science (Medical **OR** Non-Medical)

Humanities stream for class XI is known as Lower Six A stream or LVIA.

Commerce without Mathematics stream for class XI is known as Lower Six B stream or LVIB.

Commerce with Applied Mathematics stream for class XI is known as Lower Six C stream or LVIC.

Science stream (Medical **OR** Non-Medical) for class XI is known as Lower Six D stream or LVID.

For each stream, there are five categories of subjects. A child has to take minimum of five subjects in each stream. A child may opt for an additional subject as his/her 6th subject from the applicable list of subjects mentioned below. However, the school will not be able to prepare the child for the 6th subject. The school will only conduct tests/examination for the 6th subject opted by a child.

Important Note:

1. In Humanities [i.e. Stream – A], if a child takes Both History and Psychology from Category 2; History will be treated as main subject and Psychology will be treated as 5th subject. In that case, the candidate can only opt for either Political Science or Economics under the category 3 and cannot opt for both.
2. In Humanities [i.e. Stream – A], if a child takes Both Political Science and Economics from Category 3; Political Science will be treated as main subject and Economics will be treated as 5th subject. In that case, the candidate can only opt for either History or Psychology under the category 2 and cannot opt for both.
3. In Humanities [i.e. Stream – A], if a child takes Applied Mathematics as his/her 5th subject, he/she will have to attend the Applied Mathematics classes with the students of ‘Commerce with Applied Mathematics’.
4. In Humanities [i.e. Stream – A], it will be mandatory for a child to opt either for Geography or Biology as one of his/her main subject from the Category 4.
5. In Humanities [i.e. Stream – A], it will be mandatory for a child to opt for at least one subject from the first four categories.

Important Note:

In Commerce without Mathematics [i.e. Stream – B], it will be mandatory for a child to opt for at least one subject from all five categories.

Important Note:

In Commerce with Applied Mathematics [i.e. LVI C], it will be mandatory for a child to opt for at least one subject from the 1st category and there will be no options in the other four categories.



Stream D: Science (Medical and Non-Medical (LVID))

Important Note:

In Science [i.e. Stream – D], a child either has to opt for Medical (PCB) or Non-Medical (PCM). A child will not be permitted to opt for PCMB (i.e. a child will not be able to opt for both Mathematics and Biology). It will be mandatory for a child to opt for at least one subject from all five categories.
