NOŢES.

- 1. Preference is given to children of British soldiers serving with the Army in India.
- 2. Children are accepted for admission on the understanding that they will remain for the whole year, preferably longer unless leave, transfer or other unforeseen circumstances compel the parents to withdraw the child earlier.
- 3. Children whose fathers are on the active list of the Regular Army will not be admitted unless the agreement relating to pay is signed.
- Children whose fees are more than two months in arrears are liable to be returned to their parents at the latter's expense.
- 5. Parents and guardians wishing to remove a child from the School must give fourteen days' notice of their intention, in writing, to the Principal, accompanied by a remittance of the amount due on account of the child to the date of removal.
- 6. The orders under which free passages are granted for children and their guardians proceeding to and from Sanawar, are given in A II 114 of 1937.
- 7. A child is ineligible for admission if it is idiotic or subject to some disease or infirmity which will render education impossible. or very difficult, or which may hereafter hinder candidates from earning their livelihood.
