Hercules demanded to be paid one-tenth of the cattle that Augeas owned. Augeas agreed, because he was sure that the hero would never be able to finish the task.
- 4. Hercules glimpsed the kingdom's main river Alpheus glinting in the sun. Immediately he found the answer. He would change the direction of the river. Hercules started digging near the river's source to the stable's main entrance. He made the channel narrow, so that the water gushed with tremendous force, sweeping through the stable and carrying all the litter out with it. Such was its power that not a scrap of litter was left!









