Dear Parents,

Warm greetings from Sanawar!

I trust that this finds you and the family in the very best of health and circumstances.

The Lawrence School, Sanawar strongly believes in the fact that monetary constraints should not be an obstacle for a student to have access to quality education. As of this point of time, the School is already disbursing considerable scholarships to deserving students, as well as providing Defence bursaries to wards of defence personnel.

It is my privilege to inform you that in order to assist those of our Community of Learners who are in need of financial assistance, the school has instituted the 'Sanawar Cares Scholarship Fund'. This has been set up with the objective of providing scholarships to eligible students on a need cum merit basis. Consequently, the School is pleased to extend this Scholarship Scheme, which is an initiative by the school to support those of our students whose parent may be facing financial constraints. The Scholarship will be awarded each year primarily to meritorious girl students found eligible for financial assistance on account of financial distress of their parents.

The eligibility criteria for availing scholarships under the 'Sanawar Cares Scholarship Fund' are as follows:

- The child should be academically proficient. The marks scored must not be lower than 90% and the child should be an active participant in curricular activities/sports.
- The child must continue to be on the roll of the School on the date of award of the scholarship.
- The child should continue to do well in succeeding classes. The child must not be on a House List/Headmaster's List for poor academic performance and must maintain excellent overall discipline, that is to say, must not get a written warning/censure or display poor discipline/unruly behaviour.

Preference will be accorded to candidates who have not availed any prior scholarship/financial assistance/bursary from the School.

Parents suffering from financial distress may apply for their ward's scholarship under the 'Sanawar Cares Scholarship' and are required to submit the hard copy of the following documents to the School Office by the 15th March, '25 for the Academic Year '25-'26:

- ✓ ITR of both parents for the last 3 financial years.
- ✓ Recent active Bank Statements of last three years in which banking transaction of the family takes place.
- ✓ Any other documents to substantiate financial distress.

The applications will be scrutinized by a School Committee which is directed to ask for documents and such evidence, as may be deemed fit from the parents to substantiate financial distress.

The scholarship will be administered by the School under the stewardship of the Headmaster whose decision in all matters relating to the Scholarship will be deemed to be final.

If the application is considered eligible, the amount of scholarship will be credited to the student's personal account with information to the parent.

We remain certain that the parents will appreciate the School's efforts to support and to assist those of our stakeholders who are in financial distress.
