(ii) As a part of their **Personal Project** all students are encouraged to find Innovative, real world solutions to the problems/threats that negatively impact their surroundings/world. These areas may include Pollution, Crime, Forest Fires, Water Crisis, Poverty, etc. This is by no means an exhaustive list!

The Reading Awards accreditation as well as Personal Project will be taken into account for other School honors.
